Five Things To Do If You Have Found A Dog



- Check for a license or ID tag. No tags? Ask around your neighborhood in case the dog lives nearby.
- 2. Take the dog to the nearest veterinarian or shelter to have the dog scanned for a microchip and checked for a tattoo.
- 3. Notify all of the correct authorities to report the dog found. Call your local police (non-emergency line). Also, call your local animal control agency (ACO), to complete a found dog report or bring the dog to them if you are unable to keep the dog while searching for the his/her owner.
- Create "found dog" flyers and post them around the neighborhood and at animal service businesses.
- Post the dog on the lost and found section of your local craigslist, Nextdoor, in your local paper (found ads are often free) and on other lost and found Internet/Facebook sites.
